- 5) The CSCE - CHD - process:

Tobias Wikström from RFSL has phoned me and told that the parallel-activity on gay/lesbian rights in Moscow the 7-8 of September will take place and up to a couple of days ago 10 people from outside USSR had registered.

Following ILGAs (John Clarks) letter to the foreign ministers of the CSCE-countries, Ole Espersen has written to the Danish foreign minister urging him to support the proposal from ILGA and stating that it would be very important and promoting for the CoE-work with the recommendation if the CSCE-conference could follow the ILGA-proposal.

I have arranged a meeting with the leader of the Danish delegation to the CSCE-meeting in Moscow in order to give him arguments for the proposal. Please do the same in your country.
